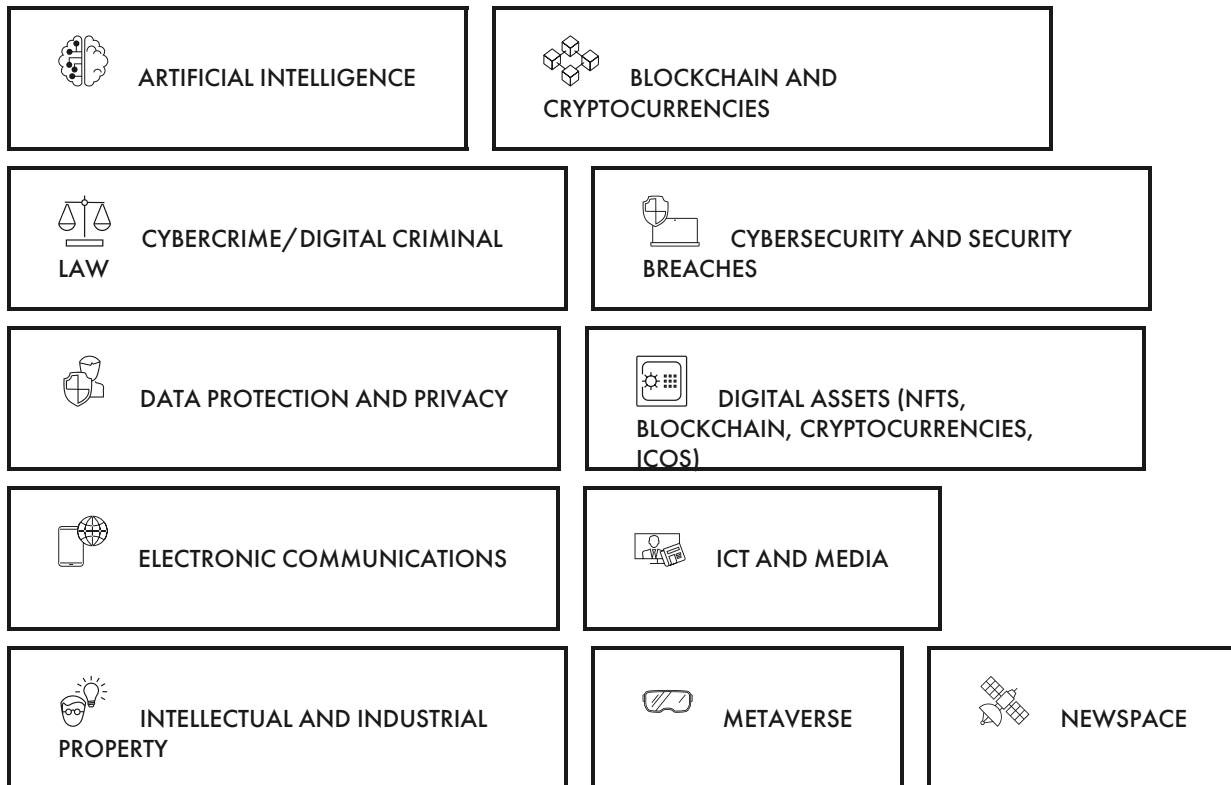
Winnie has 20 years of experience in the TMT and FinTech practice areas in Singapore and the United Kingdom.
